

1. Kids/ Father Activities

- **Create a trust walk outside.** Place objects around your yard or a familiar place that would bring back memories of times you have shared with your father. You could blind fold him as we do during our CSE trust walk, lead him to the objects and let him guess what they are without seeing them. Some ideas; something you made for your dad (like a clay sculpture from first grade), tickets from an event that you went to together, a Trophy or ribbon you won, a souvenir from a vacation...
- **Read to your dad** one of your favorite books that you shared together when you were younger. See what memories the story or book itself bring up. Or, let your dad read to you from one of his favorite books whether you like the book or not!
- **Create a special treat for your dad.** Bake something that he likes, create an appetizer for him (like cheese and crackers with grapes), make a drink with mint leaves, mineral water and lemon. Then set a special place where the two of you can share the snacks.
- **Make your dad a “Best Nap Ever” nest.** Fill it with pillows and blankets and maybe that special snack you made and leave him to rest quietly.
- **Go on a road trip or bike trip** to one of your dad’s favorite places and make a movie or photo collection of your day.
- **Build something together,** a puzzle, LEGO monster, a fort out of pillows and blankets, a slide out of boxes...
- **Do one of your dad’s least liked chores** like take out the trash or mow the lawn or bring in the mail for a week.
- **Let your dad tell you as many “Dad Jokes, Dad Stories, or Dad’s Words of Wisdom”** as he can in 15 or 30 minutes. Maybe you remember some he forgot!
